For the position of Education Officer, we had three candidates. Matt Kemp, Muhammed Sohail Naeem, and Jamie Sellers.

There were 1918 votes in this election, making quota 959. In round 1 Matt received 835 votes, Muhammed received 311, Jamie received 706 and RON received 66. In round 1, no one reaches quota so RON is removed and the votes redistributed.

In round 2, quota is 933. Matt has 843, Muhammed has 316, and Jamie has 707. No one reaches quota so Muhammed is excluded and quota recalculated.

Votes are transferred and in round 3 quota is 814. Matt receives 822 and Jamie receives 746 votes. Matt is therefore elected as your Education Officer 2024/2025.

For the position of Wellbeing Officer, we had three candidates. Kay Adeyemi, Zoe Garnett, and Alys Webber.

There were 1933 votes in this election, making quota 966.5. In round 1 Kay receives 324, Zoe receives 895 votes, Alys receives 685, and RON receives 29. RON is excluded and quota recalculated.

In round 2 quota is 954. Kay receives 326, Alys receives 686 and Zoe receives 896. Kay is excluded and quota is recalculated.

In round 3 quota is 836. Zoe receives 933 votes and Alys receives 740, so Zoe is therefore elected as your Wellbeing Officer for 2024/25.

For the position of Development and Democracy, there were three candidates: Tom Robinson, Esther Thornton, and Lennox Uche.

In this election there were 1969 votes and quota is 984. In round 1 Tom receives 968 votes, Esther receives 722, Lennox receives 255 and RON receives 24. RON is excluded and quota recalculated.

In round 2, quota is 975 and Tom receives 972, Esther 723 and Lennox 256. Lennox is excluded his votes redistributed and quota recalculated to 882. In round 3 Tom receives 1005 votes and Esther receives 760 votes. Tom is therefore elected as your Development and Democracy Officer for 2024/25.

In the election for Experience and Community there were three candidates; Sophie Borman, Olly Draisey, and Dinosaur.

There were 1971 votes in this election and quota is 985. In round 1 Sophie received 852, Dinosaur received 702, Olly received 393 and RON received 24. However, at the end of Round 1, Dinosaur has withdrawn from the Election and their votes will be redistributed.

In round two, we exclude Dinosaur following their withdrawal from the election. This makes quota 738.

In round 2, Sophie receives 971 votes, Olly receives 471 and RON receives 34.

Therefore Sophie is elected as your Experience and Community Officer 2024/25, completing your officer elect team.
